Did you know that since the start of the school year in September 2016, Friends of Great Rollright Primary School have paid out on average £2,500 a month for the benefit of EVERY child in our school. This has allowed us to pay for a huge range of things including the fantastic falconry visit all children enjoyed during World Book Week, daily fresh fruit for all KS2 children, a set of iPads, outdoor equipment for the KS1 area and for the music lessons all year 5 and 6 children receive. This is just a small selection of the things Friends has paid for, but they would not have been possible without fundraising. This is an ongoing mission as we wish to support the school and our children in every way we can.

Welcome to our 100 CLUB – a great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

You complete and sign the attached membership form and Standing Order mandate for £2 a month (or £24 annually) or pay by cheque (annual payment only).

This buys you one membership number (we will allocate), which enters you into the monthly draw. **You may purchase more than one number**. All participants must be over 16. Please ask family members and friends if they would like to participate, anyone can participate subject to the rules. If you would like extra 'Sign Up' and 'Standing Order' sheets please contact as per details below.

The draw will take place on the 1st of each month starting on 1st May 2017. To be included in this draw, please return your 'Sign up' sheet and cheque (if paying annually) to Helen Hare at Great Rollright Primary School no later than Monday 24th April and, if paying monthly, your 'Standing Order' sheet to your own bank (most banks allow you to set up a standing order via your online banking which would mean you do not need to give them the form).

If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address and the name of the winner published in the school newsletter and on the Friends' Facebook page.

The prize fund will be 40% of the membership fee taken that month, except for the draw on 1st December which will be a Christmas bonus fund of 80%. The remaining money goes to the school to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Friends bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The annual prizes will total 43% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5% for 11 out of 12 months. The prize for December will be higher with a 1st prize of 50%, 2nd prize of 20% and 3rd prize of 10% of the monthly income.
5. The 100 Club is a small society lottery and is open to all. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
9. The draw shall be made by a member of the Friends committee plus an independent observer on the first day of each month. If the first day of the month falls on a weekend the draw will take place on the Monday after. If the draw falls outside of term time the draw will take place on the first day of the month and the winner notified as stated above. The winners will then be published in the first newsletter of the next term.
10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the Friends' Facebook page.
12. The 100 Club will be run by a sub-committee of Friends members. In case of any dispute the decision of the 100 Club Committee is final.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Friends funds after six months.
