

The school will:


- ✓ Provide a daily act of Christian worship

The staff and the Governors of the school rely on you to:

- ✓ Make sure that your child has everything they need for the day and is wearing school uniform.
- ✓ Make sure your child's complete named PE kit is in school every Monday and stays in school all week.
- ✓ Send your child to school with a named water bottle.
- ✓ Share homework activities with your child and return the work to school at the right time.
- ✓ Support the school's policies and meet regularly with teachers to discuss your child's progress.
- ✓ Keep us informed of circumstances which might affect your child's ability to learn.
- ✓ Abide by the No Smoking Law on school premises.
- ✓ Keep the school safe and clean by keeping dogs (except for dogs supporting individuals with disabilities) off the school premises unless invited for educational purposes.
- ✓ Support us in discouraging abusive language by never swearing or using bad language in school.
